- 1) If you can't register on Sept 3rd, ask a friend, family member or neighbour to register for you. A late fee of \$5 will be charged for registrations taken beyond Sept 3rd. To register for programs after Sept 3rd, contact Nadine at 477-0181 or at [renenadine56@hotmail.com](mailto:renenadine56@hotmail.com).
  - 2) Membership (\$10.00) is required to register for programs. The SCA honours other community association memberships. Memberships may be purchased on registration night.
  - 3) Classes require a parent or adult convener. This person is responsible for phoning or emailing (if time permits) participants in advance of the program start date to remind them of the dates/cancelled dates, ensuring that the facility rules are followed, aiding the instructor if necessary, and distributing evaluation forms.
  - 4) An (\*\*) indicates a joint program with another community association, therefore there may be limited registration spaces. The SCA reserves the right to cancel programs (i.e. insufficient enrollment, lack of instructor...). Classes are subject to cancellations and time changes. Rescheduling will be attempted but is not guaranteed.
  - 5) On registration night, volunteers are able to sign up their own (and only their own) family members for programs before the general public arrives at 6:30 PM. If you wish to volunteer please contact Rachelle at 668-2543.
  - 6) The SCA presently subsidizes all programs offered within the community and will provide individual support for families who are unable to participate in programs due to financial burden.
  - 7) Minimum age requirements are necessary for safety concerns and social/physical readiness. Children must be the minimum age for the program before that program's start date.

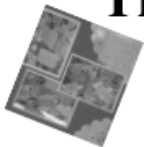

## AN UPDATE FROM YOUR CITY COUNCILLOR...



I hope everyone is having a wonderful summer. As I write this article towards the end of July, we have had quite a mixture of weather! Sunny skies, rain, hail and even tornado warnings last weekend. All and all I think it has been a decent summer and let's hope that it gets even better! We deserve it!!!

There are many things happening in our Ward and Silverspring as usual! I do receive many calls about the dust in the area. This is mainly because of all of the construction taking place. I have arranged with the City to deal with the dust. They have been diligent in putting various products on the roads to alleviate some of the inconvenience of dust. We do have to keep in mind that because of all of the construction, it is something that all of us will have to continue to deal with. Thanks for your cooperation on this.

The reconstruction of eastbound Attridge Drive from Berini Drive to Kenderdine Road began on Monday July 21 at 9:00 a.m. During construction, two-way traffic on this section of Attridge Drive will be accommodated in the westbound lanes. In addition to this closure, the curb lane of Berini Drive northbound will be closed by the intersection of Attridge Drive to provide a staging area for the crews. The work should be complete and the roadway re-opened in four to six weeks, weather permitting. Motorists are reminded to please drive carefully, obey all road restrictions, and watch for work crews in the area.

Traffic lights will be installed at Rever Road and Attridge Drive by the end of the summer. This has been a long time coming, but better late than never. These lights will help the traffic going in and out of the area.

I have been trying to get "Deer Crossing" signs at Konihowski Road and Somers. I am working with the Meewasin Valley Authority on this and hope to have them in place very soon. The Natural Grasslands in Silverspring are a great resource and an area to be proud of in Ward 10. We want to keep the people and the deer safe!
